INVEST IN TRANSPORTATION

Transportation Summit

Parsons-Brinkerhoff has proposed a simulation of traffic improvements in Green Hills for use at the community-wide Transportation Summit. The price for the traffic studies and simulations is \$29,000.

Parking

Spotwise, a Nashville company, is pulling together an innovative and lower-cost method for collecting

parking lot data for near-real-time translation to consumers via mobile app or dynamic sign. The price per lot starts at \$25/space for hardware plus \$3/space per month for monitoring.



Internal Circulator

An internal circulator could be a great addition to the neighborhood, particularly with the advances in pushing real-time location to riders.

To investigate, the Alliance for Green Hills will offer a trolley during the holiday season - not only to alleviate traffic, but also to study ridership in partnership with the Lipscomb Institute for Sustainable Practices. We are seeking \$2,500 in sponsorship.

Beautification & Greenspace

Beautification of bus shelters, trash cans, recycling cans, newspaper

boxes, utility poles, not to mention landscaping and trees -- these changes are all within our reach, but we must start with a maintenance fund in order to be responsible stewards of these improvements. Our goal is to build a modest maintenance fund to start - \$5,000 to add beauty and function to the Green Hills Center.
